ENTRIES:

An Open Check is acceptable for entries only. All stall fees must be paid in full by the closing date of September 28, 2018. The word "Entry" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must be filled in completely and properly signed before numbers will be issued.

Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any/all entries, return any money paid for all or entry fees without explanation or recourse to the show for liability of compensation.

PAYMENT:

Stalls are \$100.00 each. No entries will be accepted and stalls cannot be reserved unless accompanied by payment in full for stalls.

Open checks will be accepted for processing **ENTRIES ONLY**. All Accounts **MUST** be settled by Saturday, **October 13, 2018**.

REFUNDS:

Entry fee refunds requested prior to the entry closing date (September 28th) will be made in full less the non-refundable office fee (per horse) of \$15.00. After the closing date, entry fees will be refunded only with a veterinarian's certificate. **STALL FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.**

POST ENTRIES:

Entries postmarked after September 28th, except those for stake and championship classes, will be considered post-entries and will be charged \$25.00 per horse in addition to the regular entry fee. Post entries will also be accepted during regular office hours.

SCRATCHES:

Must be made in the show office by 9:00 A.M. for morning performances and during regular office hours for evening performances.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE:

Tuesday--Office will be open from 1:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M.

Wednesday--Office will be open at 9:00 A.M.
Office Hours will be posted for the remainder of the show.

STABLING:

Stalls will be available from Monday, October 8 through Sunday, October 14 @ \$100.00 per stall and does not include first bedding. **STALL WILL NOT BE RESERVED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY PAYMENT OF STALL FEES.** An additional \$15.00/day per stall will be charged for horses arriving prior to Monday, October 8 (payable to Morgan County Celebration Arena).

PORCHES:

A limited number of front porches are available for \$30.00 per porch.

GROUNDS FEE:

A grounds fee of \$30.00 per day/per horse will be assessed for all horses not paying a stall fee.

DAMAGES:

All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will be charged accordingly.

WARM-UP AND SHOW RING PROCEDURE:

The gate to the show ring will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Rider conflicts shall be worked out with the Paddock Master. Due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed, on the basis of PA malfunction.

Exhibitor and trainers are cautioned as to their conduct in and around the show and warm-up rings, especially in respect to schooling of horses. Items such as **Chains, Tape Measures, Blow Horns, Air Cans, Split Bamboo Poles, or Whips Longer than 6 Feet** that would alter or disturb the performance of a horse are prohibited. Stretchers on Pleasure horses will not be allowed in the warm-up area.

DISCIPLINE:

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver or attendant shall be

grounds to disqualify the horse. The owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified horse.

SHOW COMMITTEE:

Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision will be final. The show manager/committee will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. In the event of a protest, the fee is \$100.00 payable to the Alabama Charity Championship Horse Show.

CLASSES:

The show committee reserves the right to limit entries, change, cancel, limit, or combine classes at its discretion to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries, without claim for damages. **Ten and under classes will split at 12, driving classes will split at 15, and all other classes will split at 20.**

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

The following descriptions are used for this horse show. **Stake classes:** Only opportunity to show in a particular division, no championship is offered (primarily young horse classes). **Championship:** Final competition for a particular division that requires a qualifier (**will not be stripped**). **Grand Championship:** Final competition for a particular division (**will not be stripped**).

SHOW RING:

No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform. No horse will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted at the show office or announced on the PA system by the Celebration Arena Management.

LIABILITY:

The show committee, Celebration Arena, and/or any sponsor shall not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any owner, driver, rider, trainer, attendant, spectator, animal, and/or equipment at the show.

PROPER ATTIRE:

All riders, drivers, and attendants must be neatly and appropriately dressed when entering the ring.

PETS:

Pets must remain on a leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility.

NEGATIVE COGGINS:

A valid negative Coggins test within one year of show must accompany each horse and be available for inspection by Alabama inspectors at the show grounds.

PRIZE MONIES:

Premiums will be paid by check and mailed to the address of record by December 1. **Any checks not cashed by the last day of January, 2019 will be forfeited to the show.**

PARKING:

All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs after unloading must park in the designated parking areas.

CAMPERS:

Camper hookups are available from the Morgan County Celebration Arena with payment to the facility upon arrival at the arena.

RETURNED CHECKS:

All checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$50.00 handling fee. No one will be allowed to enter if they have a bad check, handling fee or unpaid account.

CHALLENGE AND MEMORIAL TROPHIES:

The trophies will be presented to the winners of specific classes but will remain with the Alabama Charity Championship Horse Show.

BEDDING:

Bedding will be available through the offices of the Morgan County Celebration Arena with payments to the Alabama Charity Championship Horse Show at \$7.50 per bag.

FEED & HAY:

Feed and hay are not available on the show grounds. Local vendors will supply product lines and address/maps will be in the horse show office if needed.

The Five-Gaited Saddlebred should possess beauty, brilliance, elegance and refinement but its energy should be directed toward speed in an animated form. Entries shall be shown with a full mane and tail. Gait requirements are animated walk, trot, slow gait, rack and canter.

2. Adult Amateur. Open to amateur exhibitors 18 years and over. Judged on manners, performance, presence, quality and conformation.

The Three-Gaited Saddlebred should be the epitome of beauty, brilliance, elegance, refinement and expression. Its gaits are collected and its energy directed toward animation and precision. It is shown with a roached mane and tail. Two-Year-Olds may be shown with a full mane and tail. Roach or full tails are permitted. Gait requirements are animated walk, park trot and canter.

It is shown with a full mane and tail. Horses are to enter the ring at a park trot. Qualifying gaits are animated walk, park trot, "show your horse." Exception: "show your horse" is not called for in an amateur class.

Horses shown in any class of this division are ineligible to compete in the Saddlebred Performance Division (i.e. Three-Gaited, Five-Gaited and Fine Harness) or the Saddlebred Pleasure Division (including Park Pleasure) at the same competition except they may compete in In-Hand or Model classes. Qualifying gaits are animated walk or flat walk, trot and canter.

High, natural, free-moving action is desirable. Laboring action due to excessive weight of shoes or length of foot is penalized. Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Horses showing in the English Show Pleasure division may wear tailsets or bustles, but may not show with the tail gingered, tied or braced, and unset tails will not be penalized. Braids and inconspicuously applied hair in mane and tail are permitted. Shoe bands and pads are permitted. Quarter boots are permitted only in Five-Gaited classes. Qualifying gaits in under saddle classes are flat walk, trot and canter plus slow gait and rack in Five-Gaited classes. In driving classes, the gaits are flat walk, trot and extended trot. Manners and suitability as a Pleasure mount are paramount. Transitions from one gait to another should be smooth and effortless. Light contact with the horse's mouth must be maintained. Special emphasis is placed on a true, flat walk. Entries must stand quietly and back readily in the lineup. Classes are open only to mares and geldings. Horses are to be shown by an Amateur or by a Junior Exhibitor. All classes in this division are Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED ENGLISH COUNTRY PLEASURE

The English Country Pleasure horse may be less showy than the Show Pleasure horse but should still be typical of the breed. Easy, ground-covering action is desired. As in all Saddlebred sections, the best quality specimens of the breed should prevail. Must be plain shod or unshod. Permissible as plain shod shall be a shoe (inclusive of caulks), which may be thicker at the heel and may include toe clips and side clips. Also permissible is an eggbar shoe. Not permissible as plain shod: bands, bars, pads of any kind, wedges, lead, springs, any attachment that extends below the bottom of the shoe, and any foreign substance not specified as permissible. The sole and entire frog of the foot must be visible. Any animal with prohibited shoeing must be disqualified from further competition at that competition and forfeit all entry fees and winnings. Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Tails must not be gingered. Classes are open only to mares and/or geldings. Qualifying gaits in under saddle classes are flat walk, trot, extended trot and canter. In driving classes, the gaits are a flat walk, trot and extended trot. Manners and suitability as a pleasure mount are paramount. Special emphasis is placed on a true, flat walk. Entries must be asked both ways of the ring to halt and stand quietly on the

rail. Horses must stand quietly and back readily in the lineup. All classes in this division are Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality, 25% on total conformation.

ROADSTER DIVISION

Roadsters in the Bike sections are able to strongly perform three distinct speeds at the trot while maintaining their form and have the look of a refined race horse or pony. Roadsters competing under saddle should be pretty and have the natural ability to carry their head high. The principal gait assignment for Roadsters is the trot. Roadsters must enter the ring clockwise at a jog-trot then show at the Road Gait; turn counter clockwise at the jog-trot, show at the Road Gait and then trot at speed. Judges must emphasize that Roadsters are to be shown at three distinct speeds. At all speeds they should work in form; that is their chins set and their legs working beneath them, going collectedly. At the trot a horse whose action feature folding of the knees, flexing of hocks, with straight true action of front legs and with hocks carried close together and with motions coordinated, is executing a balanced trot. Long sprawling action in front, dragging or trailing hind legs and straddle gaited action behind makes a balanced trot impossible. Animation, brilliance and competition ring presence should characterize the Roadster in working at a jog-trot of road gait. When asked to drive on, the horse must show speed and go in form. Pacey gaited or mixey gaited horses that pace and rack the turns or break and run on the turns shall be penalized. Judges must emphasize that Roadsters are to be shown at three distinct speeds. Exhibitors executing gaits not called for must be penalized. Classes for Roadster Ponies to Bike are restricted to ponies 52" and under. In Under Saddle classes entries may not exceed 54". In Bike and Under Saddle classes, exhibitor shall wear stable colors, cap (or protective headgear) and jacket to match. The exhibitor's number must be worn on the back of the driver. All Junior Exhibitors must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted.
